Health, Safety & Environment Policy

Patrick is committed to providing a safe working environment, to ensure everyone gets "Home Safely Every Day" Focused on achieving high standards of Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) performance and developing a positive safety culture. To achieve this Patrick will:

- Comply with all statutory and regulatory obligations and pursue continual improvement;
- Implement and maintain a Health, Safety and Environmental (HSE) Management System consistent with Patrick's HSE Management Standards;
- Implement strategies to improve resource efficiency and minimise our impacts on the environment and communities in which we operate;
- Ensure workplace physical and psychosocial hazards and risks are systematically identified and controlled;
- Ensure that adequate resources are made available for the implementation and ongoing operation of the HSE Management System;
- Provide necessary training for managers and employees to carry out their duties safely and without risks to people, property and the environment;
- Establish measurable objectives, targets and review processes that are consistent with the Patrick HSE Management System, to foster continual improvement towards an injury, damage and environmental incident free workplace;
- Ensure that adequate consultation with employees occurs on HSE matters which have the potential to affect them;
- Incorporate safety and environmental considerations into business decisionmaking processes; and
- Communicate openly with the community, regulators, customers, and other stakeholders.

Management shall:

- Actively promote the Patrick Life Saving Commitments with a focus on managing critical risk and intercepting unsafe behaviours, through routine visible safety leadership in operational environments.
- Demonstrate safety leadership by upholding Patrick's HSE Beliefs and Behaviours;
- Promote and implement the HSE Management System by monitoring compliance with policies and procedures relevant to their area of work;
- Exercise due diligence to ensure the organisation complies with its HSE legal obligations;



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- Apply properly assessed control measures to eliminate or reduce identified HSE risk to as low as reasonably practicable;
- Ensure employees and contractors work in a safe and environmentally responsible manner, and in accordance with the regulations, procedures and safe work practices relevant to their work;
- Be responsible and accountable, and hold managers, supervisors, and employees accountable for the application of the HSE Management System and in meeting their personal HSE objectives; and
- Ensure that HSE incidents are managed, reported, and investigated in accordance with the requirements of HSE Management System.

Employees, contractors, and visitors shall:

- Uphold the Life Saving Commitments;
- Demonstrate safety leadership by upholding Patrick's HSE Beliefs and Behaviours;
- Participate in the application of the HSE Management System by working in a safe and environmentally responsible manner, and in accordance with relevant regulations, procedures and safe work practices;
- Comply with reasonable instructions given to ensure their health and safety, including adherence to company policies and procedures;
- Immediately report all HSE incidents as soon as practicably possible; and
- Support the efforts of the site Health and Safety Committee.

The fulfilment of this commitment is a shared responsibility between management, employees, customers, contractors, and visitors that will not be compromised as we get **Everyone Home Safely, Every Day**.
